Preaching (Hebrew)

Transliteration: kerygma

"a proclamation" (especially of the gospel; by implication the gospel itself): preaching.

Being trained in the proficiency of the art of preaching to the point of becoming an expert.

#1 Essential Characteristics

- A. **Integrity**: Honesty, of a good reputation, sound moral principle
- B. **Knowledge**: Having the needed information and understanding
- C. **Self-Confidence**: Being sure of one's own powers or ability
- D. Professional: Being proficient
- E. Consecrated Life: Life dedicated to the service of God; set apart

#3 Homiletics

Homiletics is the art of preaching a topic from the word of God. It is the ability to communicate the teachings of Scripture in a way that the *listener can understand*. The development of types of sermon may differ, but they should be clearly presented so that others may follow the importance of the subject introduced. The Scripture text at all times must be central (not forgotten) as it is clearly defined, explained and discussed.

#4 Exegesis

The definition of exeges is is the critical explanation or interpretation of a text, especially of scripture. It is the process of discovering the original and intended meaning of a passage of scripture. When considering the importance of knowing truth, exegetical theology is vitally important. Would you want to get to the end of your life and discover God wanted you to do this while you were doing that?

Exegesis involves...

- 1. What is the text saying?
- 2. To whom is the text speaking?
- 3. When was the text spoken?
- 4. What was the environment in which the text was spoken?
- 5. How does the text apply today?

#5 Hermeneutics

Biblical hermeneutics is the branch of knowledge that deals with interpretation. The word most often refers to how to interpret the Bible or other sacred texts from other religions. This is not to be confused with exegesis. Where exegesis refers to the interpretation of a specific Biblical text, hermeneutics is deciding which principles we will use in order to interpret the text.

Types of Biblical Hermeneutics:

- 1. The **LITERAL** Interpretation
- 2. The MORAL Interpretation
- 3. The ALLEGORICAL Interpretation
- 4. The ANAGOGICAL Interpretation


